




Reading Music


Musical notes are written on the Lines and Spaces of the Stave. We use the Spaces as reference points. They help us remember the notes of the spaces we use:

 Treble clef: F A C E. (The notes of F A C E begin above middle C)

 Bass clef: A C E G. (The notes of A C E G finish below middle C)
